On August 16th, 2017, I called the victim Melvin Carter III. I asked him if he located the serial numbers to his stolen firearms. He said he was still working on it. I asked him where he bought the firearms. Mr. Carter said he bought the .40 cal. Glock from his dad, Melvin Carter Jr. He said he was trying to contact his dad to see if he had the serial number for the Glock. Mr. Carter said he had bought the Smith & Wesson revolver a while back he thought at Bill's gun shop in Hudson, WI. He said he would try to get the serial number for both of the guns. I asked Mr. Carter if he had his dad's cell phone number so I could call him myself to see if I could locate the serial number for the Glock. Mr. Carter said his dad's C/P is [REDACTED]

I called Melvin Carter Jr. His voice mailbox was full and was not accepting voice messages. I located Melvin Carter Jr's home phone number, [REDACTED] called the home phone. No contact was made with Melvin Carter Jr. I was not able to leave a message.

I called the victim Melvin Carter III back. I told him I was not able to make contact with his dad. I told him to have his dad call me when he talks to him. Mr. Carter said he would. I told him I would like to have the serial numbers to the stolen guns so I could have them entered in a stolen. Mr. Carter understood.
